What is God called?

There are three primary Hebrew words used to refer to deity in the Old Testament.

A. "Elohim" Which is translated "God" in our English Bible. (The Greek equivalent in the New Testament is "theos") This speaks of God's greatness and power as the Creator. Also it is the Plural name for God.

B. "Adonai" Which is translated "Lord" in our English Bible. This means that God is the Owner and Master.

C. "Jehovah" Which is translated "LORD" in our English Bible.

(To distinguish "Jehovah" from Adonai," the translators of the Authorized, King James Bible had the name printed in capital letters. In some compound names, "Lord God" the Hebrew word Jehovah is translated "God" It, too, is printed in uppercase letters.)

The meaning of "Jehovah" is given in Exodus 3:13-14

_____ = "The Self-Existent One Who Reveals Himself"

The word "Jesus" is the Greek form of the Hebrew "Joshua" (or Jehoshua), and lately means "Jehovah Saviour." The New Testament clearly teaches that Jesus IS Jehovah.
